/Usage conditions Hangar 10



As of Jan. 28, 2022

When using Hangar 10, adherence to the following items is a.o. required:

- Aircrafts must be parked at Hangar 10 in a ready for towing condition.
- The parking and the travelling of Hangar 10 with motor vehicles of the tenant and its representatives is not permitted.
- The landlord does not assume any liability for possible frost damages. The tenant must take appropriate measures in case of lower temperatures and frost danger, such as the drainage of all liquids that can result in a damage at or in the aircraft.

The drainage of liquids in Hangar 10 is prohibited, Containers for the collection can be purchased through Flugbetrieb Allgemeine Luftfahrt.

- The aircraft must be secured against unauthorized entering
- Towing orders can only be placed through Flugbetrieb Allgemeine Luftfahrt.
- An aircraft technician, the crew or other, adequately qualified persons are, as a matter of principle, responsible for the

attachment and removal of the towing bars. This also applies to the connection of a multi-purpose towing bar with a towing head qualified for the aircraft.

- The towability of the aircraft must be guaranteed by the aircraft owner in form of a suitable towing bar. The München GmbH airport does not assume any responsibility for the technical safety of third-party towing bars.
- If the towability cannot be guaranteed, then the aircraft owner or the crew must clarify in advance through an email to <u>gat@munich-airport.de</u> or by a phone call through +49 89 975 21498 whether a suitable towing bar is available at the Munich airport for the aircraft type.
- The towing and the using of the hangar by aircrafts of the general aviation can be guaranteed from 0500 – 2100 UTC. Towing and hangar use processes for general aviation aircrafts cannot be guaranteed outside of the listed times.
- Smoking in Hangar 10 is strictly prohibited.

The storage of materials and equipment in Hangar 10 requires the advance approval of the landlord. The tenant must mark approved objects. The tenant must assume the costs for possible damages and their repair, which are caused by the storage of materials and equipment in Hangar 10.

All other regulations of the landlord against the users of the Munich airport in the then valid versions are also applicable. This includes a.o. the regulations for the airport usage and the fire protection code for the Munich airport and the traffic and safety rules for the non-public area.
